## **STOP HUNGER NOW MEAL PACKING EVENT**

Statesville District – United Methodist Churches will join United Methodists worldwide to *Change the World*, a church-wide event on May 14-15 that prompts members to join with others in the community to make a difference locally and globally. Statesville District United Methodist Churches will participate by packaging meals for STOP HUNGER NOW for impoverished areas around the world.

The global *Change the World* event was created as part of The United Methodist Church's Rethink Church campaign, which seeks to utilize outreach events that embrace the concept of outward-bound church to make a positive difference in the world beyond the church doors. The concept for *Change the World* originated with the Rev. Mike Slaughter, lead pastor at Ginghamburg Church in Tipp City, Ohio, who authored a book by the same name that aligns with the vision of Rethink Church.

Changed lives can change the world, and lives change when people choose to **be** available, **go** where needed and **do** what they can. Through the cooperation of all 64 District United Methodist churches we can meet the goal to raise \$50,000 dollars and have 1000 volunteers participating to pack 200,000 meals and fight hunger in our world on May 14.

Stop Hunger Now has a vision to alleviate hunger in our lifetime. The meal packaging program provides dehydrated meals to the world's most destitute and hungry in a rapid, efficient and effective manner. By distributing meals and other aid especially to school feeding programs or for disaster relief Stop Hunger Now and the Statesville District can make an impact in communities by breaking the cycle of malnutrition and hunger related deaths.

Church members and friends will gather at the Armory in Newton, (1811 S US 321) or at a warehouse, 116 Anna Drive in Statesville May 14 at 8 or 11 a.m. to package meals. Volunteers may wish to bring a hat. We continue to seek funds to reach our goal for meal packing. The greater our fundraising efforts the greater our impact can be. Fundraising events continue within individual churches and on May 2 at Chic-Fil-A, 1815 US70 SE, Hickory (across from Valley Hills Mall) from 5-8pm. 10% of the proceeds for drive through or eat in will be contributed to our Stop Hunger Now event. ## April Meeting

Treasurer Glenn Fox reported that the current checking account balance was \$1,809.21 with all expenses from last month's breakfast and the Robin's Run spaghetti supper paid. As per our agreement, a check was written for \$430 to contribute to Robin's Run. This amount represented one half of the proceeds raised by the supper. Also, a contribution of \$500 will be presented to Hospice of Alexander County at our next breakfast on April 16<sup>th</sup>. This amount is more than the proceeds of last month's breakfast, but we decided to use some of our proceeds derived from the spaghetti supper to increase our contribution to this worthy cause.

Dennis will be talking to Tim Lee about getting the youth involved in our projects so that we could share proceeds for their activities.

We made logistical plans for the community breakfast on April 16<sup>th</sup> to make sure everything was in order.

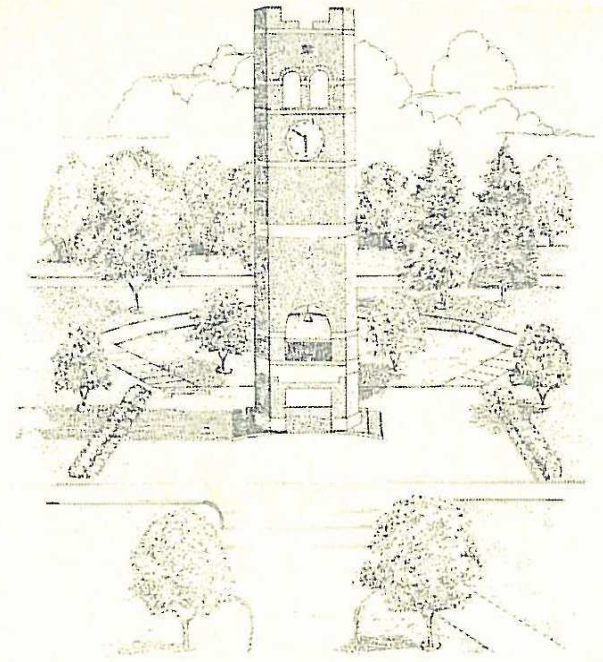
